<u>Executive Director Performance Review</u>: Coller provided information that Rosemary's review process has begun, not completed.

Concours d'Elegance: Coller commented that this event was a huge success.

Belvedere Promenade: Coller asked for support of what is now being called the Belvedere. Paul Benton of Alcorn & Benton Architects asked for Motion to notify the adjacent property owners of The Belvedere Promenade. Lane asked if both lease holders and property owners will be notified? Treasurer's Report

<u>Financial Reports</u>: Brady submitted financial reports, 6-page document ending the period of March 31st, 2012. Copies were given to all board members.

<u>501(c)3 filing</u>: Coller spoke on the requirements and benefits for LJVMA to have 501(c)3 status. It allows for LJVMA to accept donations. Mark Krasner has agreed to file this on behalf of LJVMA. This is a tax filing only, not a foundation. This may take 2-3 months to complete.

1. Bylaw Revisions & Ratifications:

Motion to ratify all changes approved last month and minor changes proposed at this meeting. See bylaws for changes.

It was moved and seconded (Berwin/Lerach).

City Budget: Brady stated the budget is for FY July 1, 2012-June 30, 2013.
 Coller commented that it is important for committee chairs to understand and know what they can spend. Coller asked committee chairs to talk with Rosemary if they do not know and if they need an explanation. Coller made it clear that we cannot go over what is budgeted.

 Associate Memberships: Levin stated the Bylaws allow us to have associate memberships each associated membership will be voted on by the board. It was made clear that the membership's primary drives are not for money but to bring businesses into the association for the betterment of the community.

- 4. Grand Openings: Chow updated on grand opening program.
- 5. Valet Parking Survey: Brady updated on the survey on Prospect Ave
- 6. <u>La Jolla Leaders Reception</u>: Coller shared that there were more influential La Jollans that attended than any other event in La Jolla in 10-15 years. Now we need to manage and make progress.
- Green Team: Lerach spoke that the Green Team is planning a guide on the website of businesses that are sustainable.

1. <u>Flower Program</u>: Niebling updated that Bridget of Bridget Blooms is now working on committee. The goal for the next meeting is to have proposals for flower baskets.
