- <u>Valet Parking Survey:</u> Brady provided update on the meeting that occurred with the three main valet companies in the Village: Sunset, Ace, Grand A survey will be conducted by LJVMA on Prospect from Cave to Herschel

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Coller commented the meeting was very positive as the valet companies want to cooperate

3. <u>New Businesses in La Jolla Village:</u> Adolfo Fastlicht spoke about 1020 Prospect St that he is negotiating to buy and convert to a modern hotel with 60 rooms. Part of Auberge Solage Group. Need to modify PDO to have additional hotel rooms approved.
